Non-recyclable waste container

- feminine hygiene products
- broken crockery
- household items
- street sweepings
- ashes
- broken light bulbs
- nappies
- used wallpaper
- greaseproof paper
- broken glass
- dirty paper
- vacuum cleaner bags
- mirror glass
- cleaning cloths, etc.

Not the following please!

- construction debris
- excavated soil
- hazardous substances
- electrical devices
- liquid waste, etc.



Biodegradable waste container

Organic waste from the kitchen and garden

- e.g. egg shells
- fruit and vegetable peelings/leftovers
- coffee filters
- tea leaves
- nutshells
- plants and twigs
- grass clippings
- moss
- fallen leaves
- sawdust and shavings
- weeds, etc.

Not the following please!

- non-recyclable waste
- compostable "plastic" bags
- glass
- metal
- menstrual pads
- cat litter, etc.



Recycling container/bag

Recyclable items made from metal, plastic or composite materials

- e.g. aluminium foil
- plastic bags and films
- food tins and drinks cans
- screw caps
- yoghurt/cream pots
- coated cardboard or paper containers
- milk and fruit juice cartons
- vacuum packaging
- plastic bottles
- children's toys
- garden furniture
- expanded polystyrene
- scrap metal, e.g. tools
- hard plastics

Not the following please!

- old electrical devices
- non-recyclable or biodegradable waste
- paper or glass for recycling



Paper container

Cardboard, paper and cardboard boxes (without contaminants and free from other substances such as metal or plastic)

- magazines
- newspapers
- leaflets
- brochures
- catalogues
- clean packaging made of paper or cardboard

Not the following please!

- Lever-arch files
- dirty paper
- paper used for personal hygiene
- used paper tissues
- grease-resistant or waterproof papers



Glass recycling container

Jars and bottles, sorted according to colour:

- white
- green
- brown

- e.g. drinks bottles
- vinegar or oil bottles
- jars used for food items
- drinking glasses, etc.

Please stick to the designated times for putting items in the containers!

Not the following please!

- light bulbs/LEDs
- spectacle glass/mirror glass
- window panes/car windscreen glass
- ceramic materials
- metal/plastic lids
- corks, aquariums, etc.
