

**Declaration
about the proper coffin fitting
for the submission for the issuance of an International corpse passport**

It is hereby declared that the corpse of _____

is coffined according to the regulations of the International Convention on the transportation of corpses of 10.02.1937 (Imperial Law Gazette, part 2, p.199) and the law on corpse, burial and cemetery matters (burial law) of 08.12.2005 (Lower Saxony Law and Ordinance Gazette No. 27/2005, p. 381) in the respective version.

The transport of the corpse is carried out as follows:

- In a metal coffin, the bottom of which is covered with a layer about 5 cm thick of an acid-corrosive substance (peat, sawdust, charcoal dust and so on) with the addition of an antiseptic agent. In the event of death from a contagious disease, the corpse must additionally be wrapped in a shroud soaked with an antiseptic solution.
- The metal coffin was then sealed airtight (soldered) and secured in a wooden coffin in such a way that it cannot move inside it.
- In a wooden coffin at least 3 cm thick: its joints are waterproof and sealed with screws no more than 20 cm apart; it is secured with metal bands.
- With a vehicle intended for transporting corpses
- When transported by air, the coffin must be equipped with a suitable pressure equalization device.
